DETAILS:

We are pleased to have **Ken Rockwood, MD, FRCPC, FRCP** as the keynote speaker for the **Center on Aging research retreat on Friday, April 3rd, 2014.** Dr. Rockwood is a Geriatrician, Professor, and Director of Geriatric Medicine Research at Dalhouse University in Halifax, Nova Scotia.
